#### **GUIDE TO THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT/RECIPIENT:**

#### I. INTRODUCTION

The Leakey Ex Student Association will award a scholarship to an individual endeavoring to further their educational goals. Any student who displays high moral character, scholarship merit and a sincere desire to achieve higher goals is eligible.

#### II. SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- 1. Each scholarship shall be a maximum of five hundred dollars (\$500).
- 2. Scholarship funds will be sent to the Registrar or Financial Representative of the school selected by the scholarship recipient to be credited to their financial account. The student will furnish Leakey Ex Student Association with the appropriate address of the institution for deposit of the funds.
- 3. Scholarship shall be granted for the education purposes for individuals seeking an associates, bachelors or technical certification.

#### III. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

#### New Applicants must:

- 1. Be a graduate of the Leakey High School by the end of the current school year;
- 2. Must show financial need;
- 3. Must plan to attend an accredited institution (college, vocational or technical school) on a full-time basis (at least 12 hours) and have a sincere desire to attain a higher education;
- 4. Must have met all the requirements for graduation and be in good standing with Leakey schools.

#### Prior Recipients must:

- 1. Be a prior recipient of a Leakey Ex-Student Association scholarship;
- 2. Be a full-time student in an accredited institution (college, vocational or technical school) (enrolled and complete at least 12 semester hours per semester enrolled);
- 3. Maintain a 2.5 GPA and be in good standing with the institution enrolled.
  - \*\*Only awarded as funds are available\*\*

While above average grades are an asset for new applicants, they are not required to compete for this scholarship as other factors will also be considered (i.e., leadership qualities, participation in

extracurricular and community activities, and teacher recommendations). Good moral character will be considered for all applicants.

#### IV. HOW TO APPLY

#### New Applicant must:

- 1. Complete all requirements of the Application for Scholarship;
- 2. Return Application by April 12, 2024 to Secretary, P.O. Box 241, Leakey, TX 78873-0241.

### Prior Applicants must:

- 1. Submit certified copy of grades from previous semesters receiving funding;
- 2. Submit proof of enrollment in upcoming semester;
- 3. Return documentation to Secretary, P. O. Box 241, Leakey, Texas 78873-0241 at least 10 days after enrollment together with a letter requesting additional funding.
